Create Professional Quick Dip Nails in 5 Minutes



Step 1 Prepare:

Sanitize the natural nail plate, push back the cuticles, slightly rough the nail plate removing all shine and dirt especially around the skin line where lifting will start,

if it is not prepared sufficiently, remove all dust with a lint free wipe.



Step 2 Tip:

Apply tip, making sure it is well attached to the natural nail with no gap. Ensure the tip covers the natural nail from side to side. Cut tip to length and shape.

If using a French, clear or coloured tip run over the top with a block buffer to remove the shine so the coating adheres better. Use lint free wipe to remove all dust.



Step 3 Coat:

Apply the coating, build up the stress area, apply base gel $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way up the nail and dip, then apply base gel all the way up the nail and dip, apply sealer dry (activator)

Keep the product a hairs width from the skin. If the product is sitting on the skin you will find it difficult to get your file in to smooth it properly around the edges, and it will not be properly sealed to the natural nail, which will cause crusting and lifting.



Step 4 Refine:

File and buff the edges to a smooth finish. You should not be able to see or feel where the product start on the nail, ensure the top is also smooth keeping an

even smooth curve from cuticle to tip with the apex over the stress area. Remove dust with a lint free wipe.



Step 5 Finish:

Decorate your nail with a top coat, colour or be as creative as your imagination will allow.
